The Toodyay St John Ambulance service has highlighted the need for a **community transport** service to assist Toodyay patients who have to travel for medical appointments. I have asked the Transport Minister to address this request.

In response to recent **power outages** in the Mid West and in particular Mullewa, I have written to the Minister for Energy and prepared a petition calling on the Minister for Energy and the Minister for Emergency Services to accept that the delivery of reliable power is essential and review the procedures in place to enable the quick restoration of power when there is a **Total Fire Ban** in place. This is an ongoing issue that I have raised with the Minister in the past.
